The July meeting is Wed. the 26th. At 7:30PM.

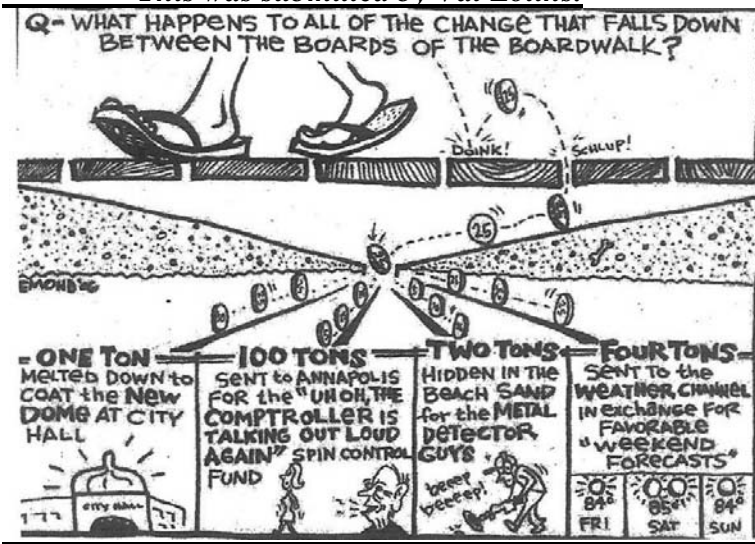
